

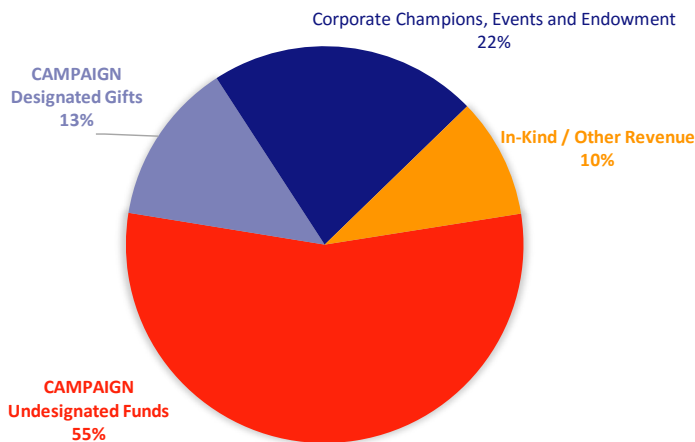


ADVANCING THE COMMON GOOD 2015-16 REPORT TO THE COMMUNITY

2015-16 FUNDING SOURCES

Corporate Champions help cover the majority of administrative and fundraising expenses of the Twin County United Way. This allows more of individual donor dollars to go directly to local programs and services.

Designated campaign gifts are dispersed according to specific donor instructions. The Twin County United Way makes it convenient for donors to support their favorite charitable organizations.

Undesignated campaign funds allow the Twin County United Way to leverage donor dollars and provide resources where support is needed most. This is our Community Fund.

COMMUNITY FUND GRANTS paid in 2015: \$385,486

HEALTH

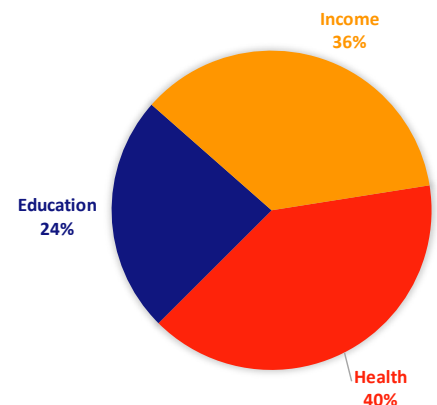
We fund programs that help improve people's health through preventative action and access to care.

KINDERGARTEN BOOT CAMP

The Twin County United Way Kindergarten Boot Camp and other kindergarten readiness efforts help ensure children have the essential skills they need to enter school ready to succeed.

FAMILYWIZE

In partnership with Familywize, the Twin County United Way distributes free prescription savings cards. In 2015, local families saved more than \$142,000 by using the discount cards on needed medications.
