# A LETTER FROM THE CEO - SUZANNE JOHNSON

It's hard to imagine a time before COVID-19 was present in our community and it's easy to get bogged down in the negativity. The past year was unpredictable, unprecedented, and unmatched. While true, Twin County United Way held strong in the face of adversity and used this as an opportunity for growth and living out our mission of identifying needs, uniting people, sharing resources, and impacting lives in Nez Perce and Asotin counties.

Over the past year, TCUW financially supported 29 Nez Perce and Asotin County programs within 22 nonprofits. A generous donation from CCI/Speer allowed TCUW to provide funding to Homes of Hope and Community Action Partnership to assist them with closing the gaps in services to those affected by COVID-19. Our Kindergarten Readiness Program kicked off in June and resulted in 42 out of 44 children graduating ready to enter Kindergarten. TCUW Board of Directors volunteered each month at the Idaho Foodbank Distribution to ensure food was provided to those who needed it most. And the Annual Day of Caring event resulted in over one hundred volunteers tackling projects at 22 non-profit sites.

For many people, assistance provided by Twin County United Way meant food on the table, formula for babies and, the ability for many to pay rent, mortgages, and utilities. For some, it was the difference between making an impossible choice between buying food or a health-sustaining prescription. The long-term consequences of choices like these will be with us for some time to come.

LIVE UNITED has never meant more than it does today. It is my honor and privilege to serve as president and CEO of Twin County United Way. Many challenges lie ahead, but there is one thing I know for sure: Nez Perce and Asotin counties know how to take care of each other, and I am confident with continued support from all of you we will persevere.
